God Speaks to Moses

1 One day, Moses was taking care of the sheep and goats of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian, and Moses decided to lead them across the desert to Sinai, the holy mountain. **2** There an angel of the LORD appeared to him from a burning bush. 2 SAMUEL 22:23-33 * PROPHETIC WORD

23 I keep Your laws (**Bible**) in mind and never turn away from Your teachings. 24 I obey You completely and guard against sin (**keep myself from guilt**). 25 You have been good to me because I do right; You have rewarded (**blessed, prospered, paid me back**) for living clean by Your standards (**Biblical standards**). 26 You are always loyal to Your loyal (**faithful**) people, and You are faithful to the faithful (**good Godly people**). 27 You are pure (**fair**) to those who are pure (**examine their heart motives**), but hostile to those who are wicked. 28 You rescue (**save**) the humble, but You look for ways to bring down the proud.
