JOHN 1:35-43 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

The First Disciples

35 The following day John was again standing with two of his disciples.

36 As Jesus walked by, John looked at him and declared, "Look! There is the Lamb of God!"

37 When John's two disciples heard this, they followed Jesus.

38 Jesus looked around and saw them following.

"What do you want?" he asked them. They replied, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?"

39 "Come and see," he said. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon when they went with him to the place where he was staying, and they remained with him the rest of the day.

40 Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of these men who heard what John said and then followed Jesus.

41 Andrew went to find his brother, Simon, and told him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means "Christ").

42 Then Andrew brought Simon to meet Jesus. Looking intently at Simon, Jesus said, "Your name is Simon, son of John—but you will be called Cephas" (which means "Peter").

43 The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, "Come, follow me."

Wives and Husbands

1 If you are a wife, you must put your husband first. Even if he opposes our message, you will win him over by what you do. No one else will have to say anything to him,

2 because he will see how you honor God and live a pure life. 3 Don't depend on things like fancy hairdos or gold jewelry or expensive clothes to make you look beautiful.

4 Be beautiful in your heart by being gentle and quiet. This kind of beauty will last, and God considers it very special. 5 Long ago those women who worshiped God and put their hope in him made themselves beautiful by putting their husbands first.

PROPHETIC WORD

PSALM 19:7-14

7 The Law of the Lord is perfect (*precepts of God's Word are full of integrity*); it gives new strength (*prosper the soul, all areas of your life*). The Lord is dependable and He gives wisdom to ordinary people. **8** The instructions of the Lord are correct (*right on*). They make the heart rejoice (*God's Word cheers you up*). God's commands give us hope and light. **9** Worshipping the Lord is sacred (*worship is a lifestyle, chemically and physically clean, pure*); all of God's decisions are correct and fair. **10** They (*God's Word*) are more desirable than the finest gold; they are sweeter than the purest honey. **11** By your teachings (*God's Word*), Lord, I am warned (*my soul shines, my life prospers*). There is a great reward (*prosperity*) in following them. **12** None of us knows our own faults (*mistakes*). Forgive me when I sin without knowing it. **13** Don't let me do wrong on purpose, Lord, or let willful sins have control over my life. Then I shall be perfect and free from the evil of sin. **14** Let my words and my thoughts (*heart attitude, feelings*) be acceptable to You, O God, my rock (*strength*) and my redeemer (*deliver*).
