So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins.

PROPHETIC WORD PSALM 37:21-31

**21** The wicked person borrows (*twines, cleaves their life around yours*), but he does not repay (*does not reciprocate what they take from you*). A righteous person is generous and giving (*kind restorer*). **22** Those who are blessed by God will inherit the land. Those who are cursed (*impoverished, ruined, driven out of their land*) by God will be cut off (*lose covenant relationships*). **23** A person's steps are directed (*prospered*) by the Lord, and the Lord delights in his way. **24** When he falls (*makes a mistake that causes a lost of inheritance blessings*), he will not be thrown down headfirst because the Lord holds on to his hand. **25** I have been young, and now I am old, but I have never seen a righteous person abandoned or his descendents begging for food. **26** He is always generous and lends freely (*partners with the right people and causes*). His descendents are a blessing (*they serve, as a result, prosper*). **27** Avoid evil (*stay away from people, situations that cause adversity to yourself and others*), do good (*always do what is right and prosper*), and live forever (*spend eternity in Heaven*). **28** The Lord loves justice (*those who do what is right at all time*), and He (*Almighty God*) will not abandon His Godly Ones (*those who are kind, do what is right*). They will be kept safe forever (*steps will be guarded*), but the descendents of the wicked will be cut off (*destroyed, consumed with troubles*). **29** Righteous people will inherit the land and live there securely. **30** The mouth of the righteous person speaks only wisdom. His tongue speaks what is fair (*encouraging, builds up, comforts*). **31** The teachings (*Bible*) of God are in his heart (*controls emotions, thoughts, words that comes out of his mouth*). His feet do not slip (*life does not waver, only influenced by the Bible, not fads, culture, other people*).
