PROPHETIC WORD PROVERBS 21:15-23

15 When justice is done, good people are happy, but troublemakers (*people who intentionally stir up trouble*) are brought to despair (*weary hopeless, critical, violently out of control*). **16** If you stop using good sense, you will find yourself dead. **17** Heavy drinkers (*drunks*) and those who live only for pleasure will lose all they have. **18** God’s people will escape (*God will provide the way of escape*), but all who are wicked will pay the price (*suffering, may financially be ruined*). **19** Better to live in a desert than with a quarreling (*nagging, complaining*) and angry woman. **20** Wise people store up precious treasure (*save money, food*), don’t waste it like a fool (*stupid person*). **21** Be kind and honest (*merciful, full of integrity*) and you will live a long life; others will respect you and treat you fairly (*show you honor*). **22** One wise person can defeat a city full of soldiers and capture their fortress. **23** If you want to stay out of trouble (*don’t want a life full of distress, anxiety, problems*), be careful what you say.
