A David Psalm

1-3 GOD, my shepherd! I don't need a thing. You have bedded me down in lush meadows, you find me quiet pools to drink from. True to your word, you let me catch my breath and send me in the right direction. 4 Even when the way goes through Death Valley, I'm not afraid when you walk at my side. Your trusty shepherd's crook makes me feel secure. 5 You serve me a six-course dinner right in front of my enemies. You revive my drooping head; my cup brims with blessing. 6 Your beauty and love chase after me every day of my life. I'm back home in the house of GOD for the rest of my life.

PROPHETIC WORD PSALM 112:1-10

1 Hallelujah (*shout praises, celebrate*)! The Lord blesses everyone with happiness and joy that honors Him and obeys His teachings. **2** The good man’s children will be powerful (*champion warrior*) in the land; and they will be blessed. **3** His family will be wealthy (*gain riches*) and prosper (*soul, health, finances*) forever. **4** They will be so kind and merciful and good, that they will be a light in the darkness (*times of death, misery, destruction*) for others. **5** All goes well for the person who is generous and lends willingly. He runs his business honestly. **6** A good person will never fail (*be troubled*), and the kind things they do for others will never be forgotten. **7** Bad news won’t bother them; they have decided (*made a willful choice*) to place their total confidence and bold trust in the Lord. **8** His heart is steady (*does not worry*), and he is not afraid (*living in fear and dread of the future*). They will live to see their enemies defeated (*those who try to cause them trouble will be triumphanted over by trusting in God*). **9** He gives generously to the needy (*Friendship House, God’s Chosen Children - The Jews*), and his kindness never fails; he will be powerful (*supernaturally strengthened*) and respected (*honored*). **10** The wicked see this and are angry (*enraged, try to provoke their anger in others*), they glare in hate (*gnash their teeth, murmurer*) and then disappear (*loose heart, fade away, no one remembers them*); their hope is gone forever (*desires of their heart is not fulfilled*).
