PROPHETIC WORD HABAKKUK 2:1-4

1 While standing guard on the watchtower (*praying over distressed situations*) and waiting to see what the Lord will tell me to say and what answer He will give to my complaint (*what will bring healing, restoration, cause a rescue to take place*). 2 Then the Lord gave me this answer (*shout this announcement to all who are afflicted*): “Write the vision down. Write it clear enough that it can be read at a glance” (*keep it simple so all can see it quickly and understand it in an instance*). 3 The vision (*revelation from God*) will happen at the appointed time (*when the congregation are assembled in unity*). But the time is coming quickly, and what I show you will come true. It may seem slow in coming, but wait for it (*do not question God’s timing*); it will certainly take place, and it will not be delayed (*will not be stopped*). 4 This is the message: “Those who are evil (*proud*) will not survive, but those who are righteous (*staying on the straight and narrow will be prosperous*) and will live (*be restored, recover what has been stolen, repair that which has been broken*) to those who are faithful to God.
