## ISAIAH 1:1 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

1 These are the visions that Isaiah son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. He saw these visions during the years when Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah were kings of Judah.

## ISAIAH 6:1-8 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

### Isaiah’s Cleansing and Call

1 It was in the year King Uzziah died that I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. 2 Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. 3 They were calling out to each other, “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Heaven’s Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!” 4 Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke. 5 Then I said, “It’s all over! I am doomed, for I am a sinful man. I have filthy lips, and I live among a people with filthy lips. Yet I have seen the King, the LORD of Heaven’s Armies.” 6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal he had taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. 7 He touched my lips with it and said, “See, this coal has touched your lips. Now your guilt is removed, and your sins are forgiven.” 8 Then I heard the Lord asking, “Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?” I said, “Here I am. Send me.”

6 For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. ## ISAIAH 53:1-10 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

**1** Who has believed our message? To whom has the LORD revealed his powerful arm? **2** My servant grew up in the LORD's presence like a tender green shoot, like a root in dry ground. There was nothing beautiful or majestic about his appearance, nothing to attract us to him. **3** He was despised and rejected—a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care. **4** Yet it was our weaknesses he carried; it was our sorrows that weighed him down. And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins! **5** But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. **6** All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the LORD laid on him the sins of us all. **7** He was oppressed and treated harshly, yet he never said a word. He was led like a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth. **8** Unjustly condemned, he was led away. No one cared that he died without descendants, that his life was cut short in midstream. But he was struck down for the rebellion of my people. **9** He had done no wrong and had never deceived anyone. But he was buried like a criminal; he was put in a rich man's grave. **10** But it was the LORD's good plan to crush him and cause him grief. Yet when his life is made an offering for sin, he will have many descendants. He will enjoy a long life, and the LORD's good plan will prosper in his hands.

## ISAIAH 54:1-3 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

### Future Glory for Jerusalem

**1** "Sing, O childless woman, you who have never given birth! Break into loud and joyful song, O Jerusalem, you who have never been in labor. For the desolate woman now has more children than the woman who lives with her husband," says the LORD. **2** "Enlarge your house; build an addition. Spread out your home, and spare no expense! **3** For you will soon be bursting at the seams. Your descendants will occupy other nations and resettle the ruined cities.

2 Please help me to understand the pathway to integrity. I will live in my own home in integrity (*simplicity, uprightness*). 3 I refuse to be corrupt or take part in anything crooked (*dealing with unfaithful people, naughty, ungodly*), 4 and I won't be dishonest or deceitful (*no dealings that are evil or wrong before God or man*). 5 Anyone who spreads gossip (*wags their tongue against another*) will be silenced (*cut off, will destroy themselves*). I will not tolerate anyone with a conceited look or arrogant heart (*people who think and act like they are better than everyone else*). 6 I will find trustworthy people to serve as my advisors (*people that are faithful to God and the Bible*), and only a person with integrity (*uprightness*) will I allow to serve (*minister*) around me. 7 No liar will live in my home; no hypocrite (*person who spreads false, deceitful rumors*) will remain in my presence. 8 Every morning I will destroy (*cut off, cut out of my life*) all the wicked people (*gossipers, hypocrites, ungodly*) in the land to rid the Lord's court (*place of worship — home, church*) of all the troublemakers (*those who stir up strife, causes afflictions in relationships*).
