PROPHETIC WORD PROVERBS 4:5-15

5 Get wisdom and learn good sense; remember the teachings of God's Word. **6** Do not abandon wisdom, and it will watch over you (*protect*). It will keep you safe. **7** Getting wisdom is the most important thing you can do. Whatever else you get, get insight (*understanding, knowledge from God's Word*). **8** If you value (*place significance, importance*) wisdom and hold tightly to her, great honors (*promotions, blessings, riches*) will be yours. **9** Wisdom will be your crowning glory. **10** My child, if you listen and obey my teachings, you will live a longtime. **11** I have taught you the way of wisdom (*what makes good sense and provides blessings into your life*); I have guided you along the right pathway for your life. **12** Nothing will stand in your way (*block your pathway*) if you walk (*live*) wisely, and you will not stumble (*faint in well doing, become weak in your commitment to God's Word*) when you run (*live the Christian life*). **13** Cling to discipline (*God's instructions that build protective restraints in your life*). Do not relax your grip on wisdom. Keep it close because it is your life. **14** Do not go where evil people go (*do not follow a bad example in speech or behavior*). Do not follow the example of cruel people (*those who cause great pain in your life emotionally and physically*). **15** Turn away from them and keep going (*do not associate with evil, cruel, wicked people*). Stay away from them (*they will cause much harm, hurt*).
