LUKE 10:2 ((WORLDWIDE ENGLISH))

2 He said to them, `The harvest is much, but there are not many people to gather it. So talk to the Lord of this harvest and ask him to send out people to his harvest.

LUKE 10:3-11 ((WORLDWIDE ENGLISH))

3 Go on your way now. I am sending you out among people. You will be like sheep among bad animals. **4** Do not take money, or a bag, or shoes. And do not stop to talk with anyone on the road. **5** When you go into a house, first say, "May God give peace to this family." **6** If a man of peace is there, your blessing will stay with him. If not, your blessing will come back to you. **7** Stay in that house. Eat and drink what the people give you. The one who works should have his pay for it. Do not move from one house to another house. **8** `When you go into a town and they take you in, eat what is put before you. **9** Heal the sick people in the town. Tell the people, "The kingdom of God has come to you." **10** But when you go into a town and they do not take you in, then go out into the streets of the town. **11** Say to the people, "We wipe off even the dust of the town that is on our feet. This will be a sign to you. But remember this, the kingdom of God has come."

(Matthew 11.20-24)

13 You people of Chorazin are in for trouble! You people of Bethsaida are also in for trouble! They would have dressed in sackcloth and put ashes on their heads. **14** On the day of judgment the people of Tyre and Sidon will get off easier than you will. **15** People of Capernaum, do you think you will be honored in heaven? Well, you will go down to hell!

LUKE 10:19-20 ((WORLDWIDE ENGLISH))

19 I have given you power over all the power of the enemy. Nothing will hurt you. **20** Do not be glad that the bad spirits obey you. But be glad that your names are written in the book in heaven.

LUKE 10:21-24 ((WORLDWIDE ENGLISH))

21 At that same time the Holy Spirit made Jesus very happy. Jesus said, 'Father, you are Lord of heaven and earth. I thank you because you have hidden these things from people who are wise and know many things. But you have shown them to people who are like children. Yes, Father. That was the way you wanted it. **22** My Father has given everything to me. No one knows who the Son is but the Father. No one knows who the Father is but the Son and those to whom the Son wants to show him. **23** Then Jesus turned to his disciples and said to them alone, 'God is blessing the eyes of people who see what you see! **24** I tell you this. Many prophets and kings wanted to see the things you see. But they did not see them. They wanted to hear the things you hear. But they did not hear them.

PROPHETIC WORD JOB 11:11-20

11 God knows who the scoundrels are. Who are worthless and sinful (*troublemakers, cause nothing but problems*). **12** Stupid people will start being wise (*have good sense, proper understanding about life*) when wild donkeys are born tame. **13** Surrender your heart (*seat of your will, decision making*) to God, reach out to God in prayer. **14** Put away (*choose to remove*) evil and wrong from your home. **15** Then you will be able to face the world with security and courage (*overflowing confidence*). **16** Then you will forget your misery (*pain, grace*) and it will be like water beneath a bridge, **17** and your darkest night will then be brighter than noonday sunshine. **18** You will live secure (*hope, peace, confidence*) and full of hope (*expectancy of what God is going to do in your life*); God will protect you (*security*) and give you rest (*free from worry*). **19** You will sleep without fear (*will not be filled with anxiety*) and be greatly respected (*many people will ask for your help*). **20** But those who are evil (*guilty, wrong because they have treated God and you wrongly*) will go blind and lose their way (*won't be able to escape their problems*). Their only escape is death (*both lose their mind and life*)! Their only hope is to take their last breath (*only way to escape the misery they have created for themselves is to die*).
