JOSHUA 24:14-15 ((THE MESSAGE))

14 So now: Fear GOD. Worship him in total commitment. Get rid of the gods your ancestors worshiped on the far side of The River (the Euphrates) and in Egypt. You, worship GOD. 15 "If you decide that it's a bad thing to worship GOD, then choose a god you'd rather serve—and do it today. Choose one of the gods your ancestors worshiped from the country beyond The River, or one of the gods of the Amorites, on whose land you're now living. As for me and my family, we'll worship GOD."

JUDGES 2:6-7 ((NEW CENTURY VERSION))

Joshua Dies

6 Then Joshua sent the people back to their land. 7 The people served the LORD during the lifetime of Joshua and during the lifetimes of the elders who lived after Joshua and who had seen what great things the LORD had done for Israel.

JUDGES 2:8-12 ((NEW CENTURY VERSION))

8 Joshua son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died at the age of one hundred ten. 9 They buried him in his own land at Timnath Serah in the mountains of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash.

The People Disobey

10 After those people had died, their children grew up and did not know the LORD or what he had done for Israel.

11 So they did what the LORD said was wrong, and they worshiped the Baal idols. 12 They quit following the LORD, God of their ancestors who had brought them out of Egypt. They began to worship the gods of the people who lived around them, and that made the LORD angry.

PROPHETIC WORD PROVERBS 9:1-12

1 Wisdom (*common sense that is Holy Spirit guided*) has built her house (*home, place where hangings make it feel comfortable*) with its seven columns (*indefinite efforts that stabilize your home*).
2 She has prepared the meat and set out the wine. Her feast is ready.
3 She has sent her servant girls to announce her invitation from the highest hills: 4 Everyone who is gullible (*foolish*) is invited! 5 All of you are welcome to my meat and wine. 6 Stop being gullible (*foolish*) and live (*restore your relationships, repair your wrong actions*). Start traveling the road of understanding (*knowledge mixed with Holy Spirit guided wisdom*). 7 Correct a worthless bragger (*arrogant mouther*), and all you will get are insults (*abuse*) and injuries (*hurt feelings and emotions*). 8 Any bragger (*conceited mocker*) you correct (*share wisdom with*) will only hate you (*they will become your enemy*). But if you correct someone who has common sense (*Holy Spirit guided wisdom*), will respect you (*have affection and appreciation for what you say to them*). 9 Give advice to a wise person, and he will become even wiser. Teach a righteous person, and he will learn more. 10 Respect and obey the Lord! This is the beginning of wisdom. To gain understanding (*perfect wisdom*), you must know (*have a relationship*) with the Holy God. 11 I am wisdom. If you follow me, you will add years to your life. 12 If you are wise (*use wisdom in your words and actions*), your wisdom will help you (*it will bring a profit to your life*). If you are a mocker (*conceited, arrogant mouth*), you alone will be held responsible (*suffer the hurt you cause*).
