PHILIPPIANS 2:3-8 ((NEW LIVING TRANSLATION))

3 Don’t be selfish; don’t try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. **4** Don’t look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. **5** You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. **6** Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. **7** Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, **8** he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal’s death on a cross.

1 CORINTHIANS 1:26-29

((CONTEMPORARY ENGLISH VERSION))

26 My dear friends, remember what you were when God chose you. The people of this world didn't think that many of you were wise. Only a few of you were in places of power, and not many of you came from important families. **27** But God chose the foolish things of this world to put the wise to shame. He chose the weak things of this world to put the powerful to shame. **28** What the world thinks is worthless, useless, and nothing at all is what God has used to destroy what the world considers important. **29** God did all this to keep anyone from bragging to him.

JOHN 3:16 ((CONTEMPORARY ENGLISH VERSION))

16 God loved the people of this world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who has faith in him will have eternal life and never really die.

((extra notes))

4 Listen to me, my people says the Lord! My teaching (*principles of the Word of God*) will cause justice (*right verdict*) to shine like a light (*produce happiness, clear understanding about life*) for all the people (*congregation*). 5 My righteousness is near. My salvation is on the way (*victory, rescue is near*). I am strong and ready; hope is coming to those who patiently wait for me. 6 Look up at the heavens (*sky*); look at the earth! The sky will vanish like smoke. The earth will wear out like clothing, and all the people will die like flies. But my victory (*deliverance*) will last; my saving power never ends (*protection for those who are right before God*). 7 If you desire to do right and to obey (*live right before God*) my teaching (*principles of God's Word*) with all your heart, then pay attention. Don't be discouraged (*pull back from doing what is right before God*) when others insult you (*say outrageous things that are not truth about you*) and say hurtful things (*ridicule, try to humiliate your life*). 8 Moths will eat them like clothing (*they will be destroyed*). Worms will devour them like wool (*something that preys on dead bodies — they are dead, full of jealousy, bitter*). But my righteousness (*justice, blessings*) will last forever, and my victory (*deliverance, health, prosperity*) will last throughout every generation.
