PROPHETIC WORD PSALM 28:1-9

1 O Lord, my rock (*defender, refuge*), I call upon You (*listen to my cry for help*)! If you remain silent, I will be like those who go into the pit (*place of discouragement*). **2** Hear my prayer for mercy when I call to you for help, when I lift my hands toward. Your most holy Temple (*worship with hands raised in the sanctuary*). **3** Do not condemn me with the wicked, with those whose words are friendly, but who have hatred in their hearts (*they sound like they are your friends to your face, but cause trouble behind your back*). **4** Treat them as they deserve! Punish them for their sins. **5** They don't pay any attention to Your wonderful deeds (*all the blessings God releases to us*). Destroy them and leave them in ruin (*pull them down so everyone will know they have done wrong things*).

6 I will praise You, Lord, for answering my prayers. **7** The Lord is my strength (*protector*) and shield (*defender*). My heart trusts Him (*complete confidence in God*), so I received help (*God delivered me*). My heart will celebrate; I will give thanks to God with my song (*praises*). **8** The Lord is the strength (*security*) of His people and a fortress for the victory of His anointed Messiah. **9** Save Your people, Lord (*deliver, rescue, avenge — fight their battles*), and bless who belong to You. Be their shepherds, and carry them forever (*tend them, release an inheritance to them*).
