PROPHETIC WORD JOB 23:6-17

6 Would God use all of His strength (*greatness*) against me? No! He would listen as I speak. **7** I am honest (*innocent*); I could reason with God (*freely speak my heart*); He would declare me innocent once and for all. **8** However, I cannot find God anywhere (*fully understand all of God's instructions*). **9** On my left side or my right side, God is always at work (*helping me advance*), though I never see Him. **10** But God knows every step I take; if He tests me (*gives me a chance to prove myself*), He will find me pure (*as pure as gold*). **11** I have never refused to follow any of His commands (*faithfully obey God's Word*), **12** and I have always treasured His teachings (*hidden God's Word in my heart*). **13** God never changes! No one can oppose God or stop Him from doing what He wants to do. **14** God will carry out (*fulfill*) what He has planned (*destined*) for me. **15** I tremble with fear (*stand in awe*) of God's All Powerful hand working on my behalf. **16** The Almighty has filled me with amazement. **17** God has covered me with darkness (*allow challenges, which has created misery*), but I refuse to be silent (*not destroyed, cut off — God's there to help me in my time of need*).
