PROPHETIC WORD MALACHI 2:4-7

4 I am telling you this, so I can continue to keep my covenant (*agreement, promise*) with your ancestor Levi (*one of the sons of Jacob — Israel*).

5 In my covenant I promised them life (*freshly watered strong life*) and well-being (*peace, prosperity*), and he (*Levi*) kept his part of the agreement by honoring me (*worshipping God*) and respecting my name (*obeying the commands of God*). **6** He (*Levi*) taught the earth (*established the commands of God, brought about stability*) and he never told lies (*did not use perverse language, talk negative about others*), and he led a lot of people turn from sin. He lived in peace and prosperity because he obeyed the Lord. **7** You priests (*both officiating priest, and those who act as priest — minister ministering to ministers — all Christians should be used of God to minister*) should be eager to spread knowledge of God, and everyone will seek you out to understand God's Will, because you speak the truth of God at all times, says the Lord All Powerful.
