PROPHETIC WORD PROVERBS 8:1-12

1 With great understanding (*spiritual discernment*), Wisdom (*skillful reasoning*) is calling out 2 as she stands at the crossroads and on every hill (*attitude determines your altitude in life, how high you climb in life*). 3 Wisdom stands by the city gate (*doors of opportunity*) where everyone enters the city. At the entrance sings its song, 4 “I am calling (*inviting*) each of one of you!” (*If you listen to the call of Godly wisdom peace will come your way*). 5 Good sense (*wisdom, spiritual discernment*) and sound judgment (*righteous thinking, decision making*) will be your (*heart of integrity receives blessings*). 6 Listen (*hear God's voice of wisdom and declare it*), because what God says through wisdom is worthwhile (*brings about excellent results*) and right (*full of integrity, prosperity*). 7 I always speak the truth (*what is trustworthy*) and refuse to tell a lie (*foul language, hatefulness, untruth*). 8 Everything I say is fair, there is nothing twisted (*misleading, deceptive*) or crooked (*distorted*) in what I say. 9 To those with insight (*discernment*), it is all clear; to the well informed (*understand God's commands*), it is all plain (*right decisions are made*). 10 Choose (*receive, obey*) God's instruction (*corrective protection*) and knowledge (*spiritual insights*) over silver and finest gold (*decisions will turnout better than if you had wealth*). 11 Wisdom is worth much more than jewels (*wealth*) or anything else you desire. 12 I am Wisdom — Common Sense (*insights*) is my closest friend; I possess knowledge and sound judgment (*witty inventions that leads to prosperity*).
