LUKE 4:18-19 ((NEW CENTURY VERSION))

18 "The Lord has put his Spirit in me, because he appointed me to tell the Good News to the poor. He has sent me to tell the captives they are free and to tell the blind that they can see again. — *Isaiah 61:1* God sent me to free those who have been treated unfairly — *Isaiah 58:6* 19 and to announce the time when the Lord will show his kindness." — *Isaiah 61:2*

COLOSSIANS 3:4-14 PROPHEMIC WORD

4 Christ gives meaning to your life (*real life*), and when He appears (*literally makes Himself known to you*), you will also appear with Him in glory (*at Christ second coming*). 5 Therefore, put to death whatever is worldly in you (*don't be controlled by fleshly desires*): your sexual passions, perversion, lust, and greed (*which is the same thing as worshipping wealth — whether you have anything or not*). 6 Because of such sins God's anger will come upon those who do not obey God. 7 You used to live that kind of sinful life (*before confessing your sins, you behaved liked that*). 8 Also get rid of your anger (*vengeance toward others*), hatred (*hateful feelings, words*), cursing (*obscene, cruel talk*) must never come from your lips. 9 Do not lie to one another (*attempt to deceive*), for you have to put off the old self with its habits. 10 Each of you is now a new person (*fresh new beginnings*). You are becoming more and more like your Creator, and you will understand Him better (*receive spiritual discernment*). 11 It doesn't matter if you are Greek or a Jew, or if you are circumcised or not, barbarian (*foreigner*), savages, slaves, or free person, but Christ in all, Christ is in all (*in Christ all old barriers that separate people must be put away*). 12 God loves you and has chosen you as His own special people. So be sympathetic (*merciful*), kind (*useful, helper*), humble (*do not put others down or humiliate them*), gentle, and patient. 13 Put up with each other, and forgive anyone who does you wrong, just as Christ has forgiven you. 14 Above all, be loving (*show benevolence, do not become bitter and hold a grudge or be hostile*). Love ties everything together perfectly.
