A Life of God-Worship

19-21 Don't hoard treasure down here where it gets eaten by moths and corroded by rust or—worse!—stolen by burglars. Stockpile treasure in heaven, where it's safe from moth and rust and burglars. It's obvious, isn't it? The place where your treasure is, is the place you will most want to be, and end up being.

1 TIMOTHY 6:6-9 ((NEW CENTURY VERSION))

6 Serving God does make us very rich, if we are satisfied with what we have. **7** We brought nothing into the world, so we can take nothing out. **8** But, if we have food and clothes, we will be satisfied with that. **9** Those who want to become rich bring temptation to themselves and are caught in a trap. They want many foolish and harmful things that ruin and destroy people.

17 "The Lord is fair in all His ways and faithful (**just, kind, merciful**) in everything He does. **18** The Lord is near (**like next of kin, a neighbor**) to everyone who prays to Him (**calls on Him with a request, in need**), those who call on Him with sincerity (**who establishes in prayer, declares things with a trustworthy heart**). **19** He supplies (**satisfies the desires of your heart**) and fulfills the needs of those who honor Him (**reverently worship the Lord**); He hears their cries and saves them (**delivers you**). **20** The Lord protects (**places a strong hedge around**) everyone who loves Him (**has strong affection in your heart for God**), but He will destroy the wicked (**they will be thrown down**). **21** I will praise You (**sing songs of worship to God**), O Lord, Your Holy Name (**I bless you Lord with Acts of Adoration and do good works for Almighty God as a praise offering unto You O Lord**).
