ECCLESIASTES 5:13-20 ((PROPHETIC WORD))

**13** The preacher says, “There is something terribly unfair (**it’s painful, tragedy**). People get rich (**get wealthy, hoard their money**), but it does them no good (**they’re still distressed, unfulfilled**).

**14** Suddenly they lose it all in a bad business deal, then they have nothing to leave to their children.

**15** We leave this world as we entered it—with nothing. In spite of all our work there is nothing we can take with us. **16** It’s terribly unfair! We leave this world just as we came. We labor, trying to catch the wind, and what do we get? **17** We spend our entire lives in darkness (**in gloomy misery**) and grief (**frustration**), sickness (**brought on by anxiety**), and resentment (**always angry at someone or something**). **18** Here is what I have figured out: The best thing we can do is eat and drink and enjoy what we have worked for during this short life that God has given to us (**instead of always being upset at someone or something, enjoy the journey**). This is what God intends. **19** If God gives you wealth and property, enjoy everything you own. You should be grateful (**giving praise to God for what you have**) and enjoy (**rejoice and be glad**) what you have worked for. It is a gift from God. **20** God will keep you so happy (**if your heart is filled with praise and thanks to God**) you won’t have time to worry about each day.
