Prophetic Word



20 Without wood a fire goes out, and without gossip a quarrel (*strife, discord*) dies down. **21** As wood fuels a fire, so a quarrelsome (*contentious, argumentative*) person fuels a dispute (*controversy*). **22** The words of a gossip are as wounds burned into your skin (*hurts for a long time, leaves scars forever*), and they go down into a person's emotions.

23 Like a clay pot covered with cheap silver, so is smooth talk that covers an evil heart (*looks good on outside, but is dirty on the inside*). **24** Whoever is filled with hate disguises it with his speech (*deceitful heart*), but inside he is a double crosser. **25** When he talks charismatically, do not trust him because of the seven disgusting things in his heart
