((THE MESSAGE))

7 The Law (precepts, statutes of God's Word) of Lord is perfect (complete, full of integrity); it gives new strength (vitality). The commands of the Lord last forever, and they give wisdom to ordinary people. 8 The Lord's instruction is right (make you go in a straight direction); it makes our heart rejoice.

➤ **PSALM 19:7-14**
((PROPHETIC WORD))

God's commands shine brightly (enlightens your mind). It makes your eyes shine (able to see clearly God's direction for your life). 9 Worshipping the Lord produces good results. All of God's decisions are correct and fair. 10 They (God's commands) are more desirable than the finest gold; they are sweeter than the purest honey.
