*(Holy Spirit guided
wisdom)*, will respect
you *(have affection and
appreciation for what
you say to them)*. 9 Give
advice to a wise person,

righteous person, and he
will learn more. **10** Respect
and obey the Lord! This
is the beginning of wisdom.
To gain understanding
(*perfect wisdom*),
