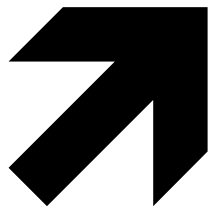
02: Road to RESENTMENT.

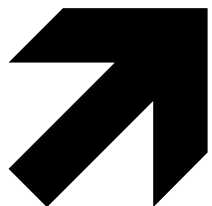
