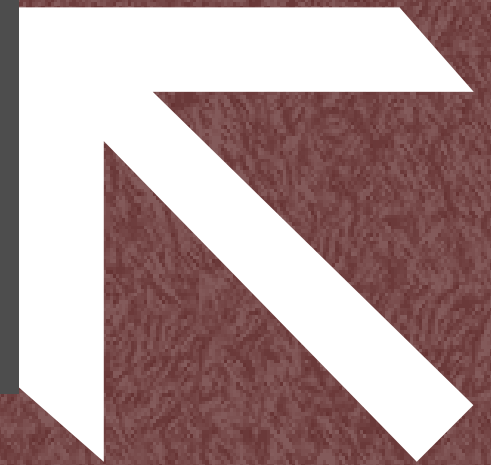

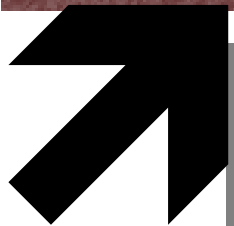

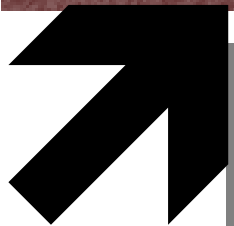

6 I am the God who was worshiped by your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.” Moses was afraid to look at God, and so he hid his face.

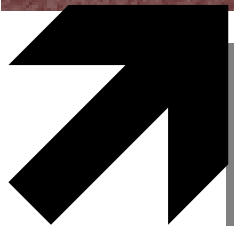

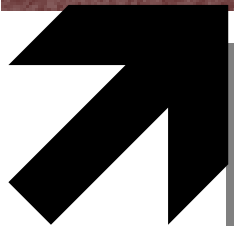

“A walking stick,” Moses replied.



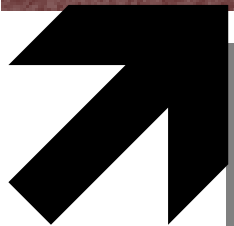

4 “Pick it up by the tail!” the LORD told him. And when Moses did this, the snake turned back into a walking stick.

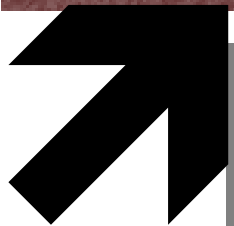

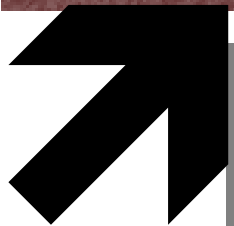
MAKING ROOM FOR MORE

4 God saw that he had stopped to look. God called to him from out of the bush, “Moses! Moses!” He said, “Yes? I'm right here!”



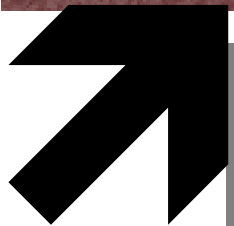

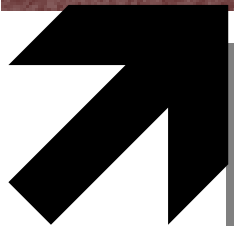
26 You are always loyal to Your loyal (faithful) people, and You are faithful to the faithful (good Godly people).

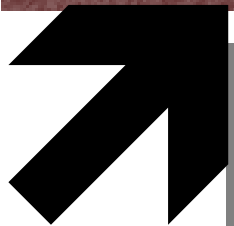
2 SAMUEL 22:23-33
